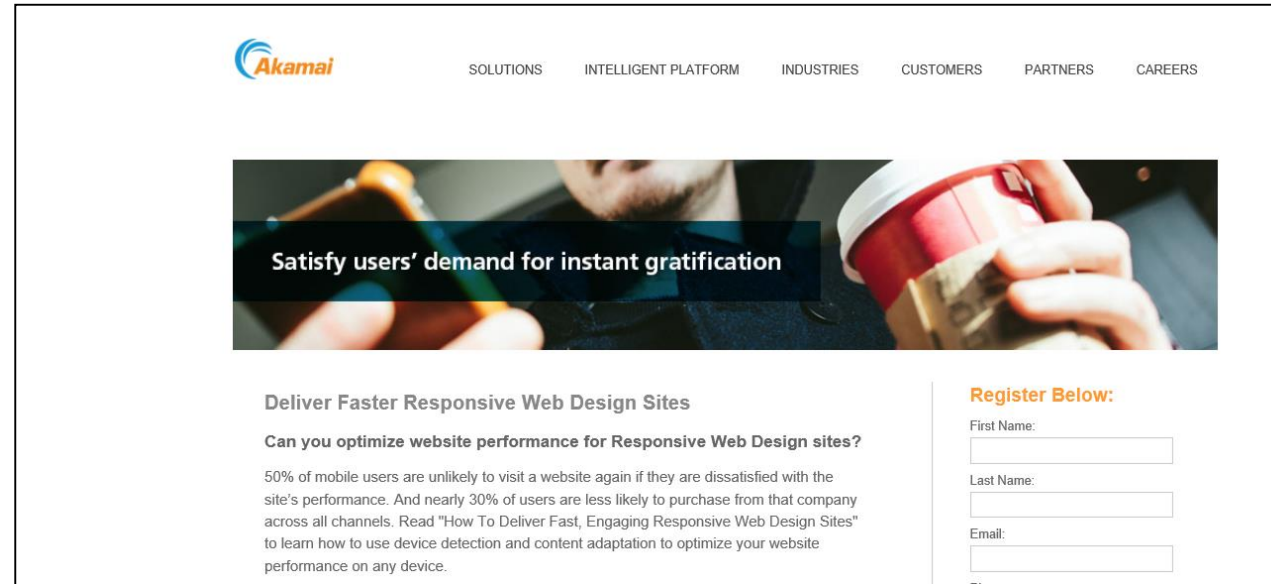

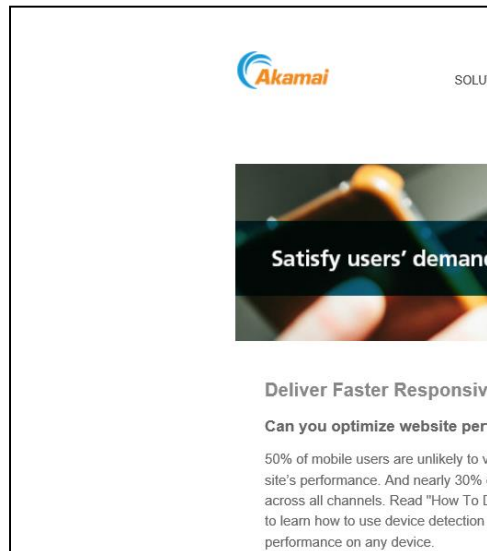
Advantages

← How viewed on a computer




← Hand-held device **WITHOUT** Responsive Design
